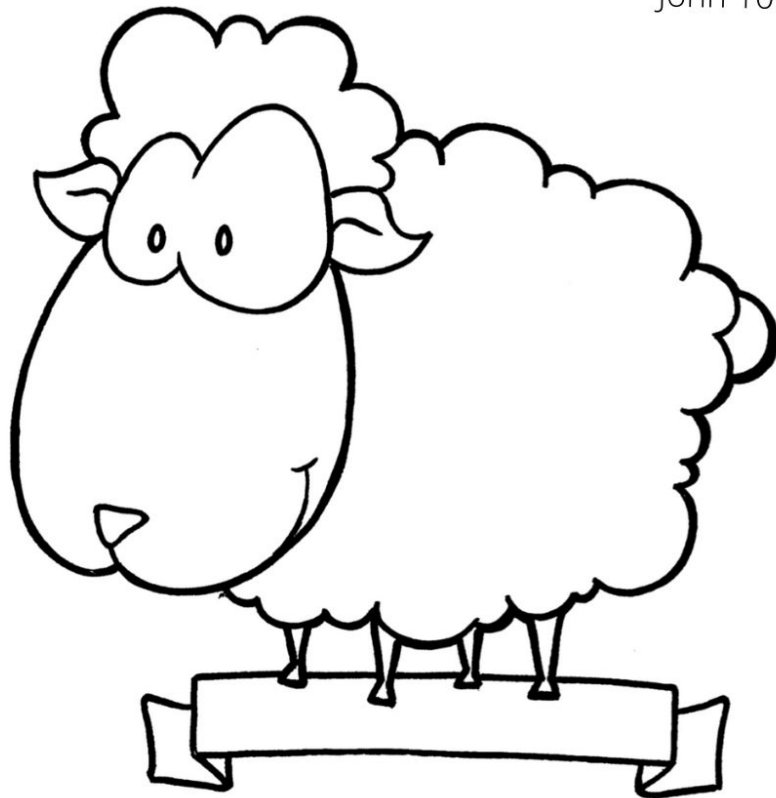
Lectionary Readings:

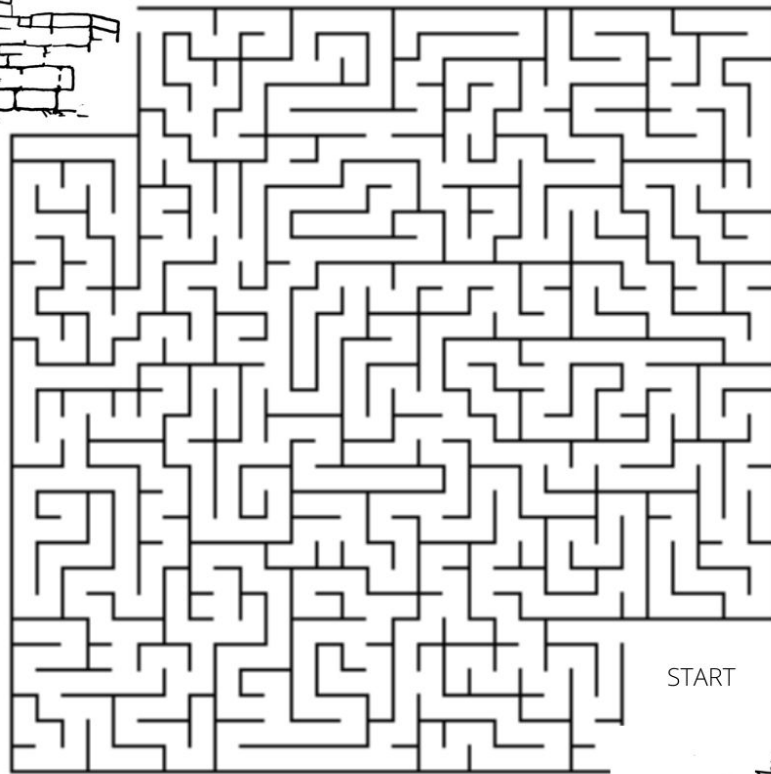
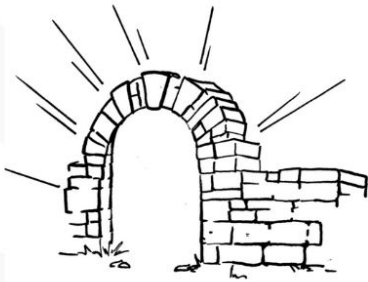
